
3. In 1881, an astronomer predicted that the Earth would pass through the poisonous gases in the tail of Halley's Comet in

- 6. Y2K, January 1, 2000. many people grew concerned that computers might bring about doomsday. The problem, first noted in the early 1970s, was that many computers would not be able to tell the difference between 2000 and 1900 dates.

Have Any Of These Been Right?


