## **Looking for the Messiah**

Daniel the Prophet prophesied Jerusalem would be rebuilt and last "Until Messiah the Prince" (Daniel 9:25). Andrew told Peter, his brother,

"We have found the Messiah," (which is translated, the Christ). And he brought him to Jesus. (John 1:41-42)

From prison, John the Baptist asked

Jesus answered and said to them, "Go and tell John the things which you hear and see." (Matthew 11:3-4)

#### **Baptized Or Not?**

Jesus' last word on salvation was:

"Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned." (Mark 16:15-16)

It is baptism, not faith, that puts one into the saving benefit of Jesus' death, as the Apostle Paul wrote:

Do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? (Romans 6:3)

Pitting verses on "faith" against verses on "baptism" was the kind of thing Pharisees did that Jesus condemned.

"Thus you have made the commandment of God of no effect by your tradition." (Matthew 15:6)

Some say, "baptism is non-essential," but Jesus said it was. Since "baptism" is into Jesus' death, how can anyone be saved before it?

Then I sent to him, saying, "No such things as you say are being done, but you invent them in your own heart." (Nehemiah 6:8)

Bible believers are getting letters charging them with violation of separation of church and state. Our reply should be Nehemiah's: You're making this up.

Jesus' response to the Pharisees was:

"Go, tell that fox, 'Behold, I cast out demons and perform cures today and tomorrow, and the third day I shall be perfected'." (Luke 13:32)

Jesus was, in effect, saying, "Nothing you say will stop Me from doing what I must do."

And they called them and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus. ... But Peter and John answered and said to them, "We cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard." (Acts 4:18-20)
