"Peace, goodwill toward men" is for those who are "baptized into Christ." Do you have that peace?

### **Getting Jesus Right: Kingship**

The New Testament writers, "did not follow cunningly devised fables" (2 Peter 1:16) when they wrote about Jesus Christ. A "fable" is a "myth, fairy tale, falsehood." At birth, Jesus was not a "king." He was called "king of the Jews" by wise men (Matthew 2:2). After miraculously feeding thousands, the people wanted to force Him to be their king, but Jesus withdrew from them (John 6:15). He entered Jerusalem, and the Jews wrongly said,

"Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the LORD!" (Luke 19:38)

Pilate wrongly titled Jesus' cross, "THE KING OF THE JEWS" (Mark 15:26). Only after His resurrection did Jesus claim,

"All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth." (Matthew 28:18)

Now He is "the King of kings and Lord of lords" (1 Timothy 6:15).
