- > Based on Self-View Personal Definition
 - Many think they want to be in this prison
 - No freedom until we see our self reality
- >Our perception of yourself not sufficient
 - >Not a true reflection Distortion
- >God's Mirror
 - >James 1:21-25
- Look at the reflection and make improvements
 - >Phil 3:13-14; Hebrews 12:1-2



Freedom from Our Self-Prisons Prison of Inferiority

- >Feeling of Defeat Defeatist Attitude
 - >Prison of the Unprofitable Servant
 - > Matthew 25:18, 25
- >Prison cell close to the previous prison
 - >Perception of self snares us
 - >Problem is looking to ourselves for power
- >Christ is our Power
 - > Ephesians 2:12-13; Romans 5:6
 - > Matthew28:18-20; Philippians 4:13

Prison of False Religion

- >A Prison of Deception and Ignorance
 - >Isaiah 66:4; 2 Thessalonians 2:10-12
 - ➤Lie = Damnation
- >A Dangerous Poison
 - **>Galatians 1:6-9**
 - >Example of Cain Genesis 4:3-7
- >Only truth will set you free! John 8:31, 32
- >Psalm 118:8 "It is better to trust in the LORD Than to put confidence in man."

Prison of Sin

- >Sin = Master // Sinner = Slave Romans 6:16
 - Sin = Death // Obedience = Righteousness
- >Sin strives with the spirit of man

Brings more strife Proverbs 17:14 "The beginning of strife is like releasing water; Therefore stop contention before a quarrel starts."
