Whose Denominations Are They?

For God is not the author of confusion but of peace, as in all the churches of the saints. (1 Corinthians 14:33)

Then, who is? Jesus had prayed over the Apostles:

"I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me." (John 17:20-21)

The Apostle Paul wrote to the church of Christ in Corinth:

Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment. (1 Corinthians 1:10)

If there are splits, divisions, or denominations among believers, they are NOT OF GOD!

Supporting Abortion

An unborn, or newly-born, baby defines "innocence," for they have not "done any good or evil" (Romans 9:11). "The king of Egypt" issued an "executive order" to Israelite midwives that:

After Jesus fed a multitude of 5000 men, not counting women and children, with five loaves of bread and two fish, He sent His disciples on the sea of Galilee ahead of Him.

But the boat was now in the middle of the sea, tossed by the waves, for the wind was contrary. Now in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went to them, walking on the sea. And when the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, "It is a ghost!" And they cried out for fear.

But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, "Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid." (Matthew 14:24-27)

They were afraid when they thought they were dealing with a "ghost," or out-of-body being, but were mistaken. Faith in Jesus Christ overcomes fear.

What scares you this time of the year? Is it houses haunted by fake "ghosts and goblins?" Or is it sights and sounds that are not human and hard to identify? Or is it make-believe "zombies," "vampires," or "werewolves?" The only time dead people walked the earth again was when Jesus Christ died on the cross, an earthquake opened graves,

And many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised; and coming out of the graves after His resurrection, they went into the holy city and appeared to many. (Matthew 27:52-53)

They proved Jesus was raised from the dead, not that we should fear the night. If you obey God, then:

When you lie down, you will not be afraid; Yes, you will lie down and your sleep will be sweet. (**Proverbs 3:24**)

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
