Were Adam and Eve Real?

You shall observe My judgments and keep My ordinances, to walk in them: I am the LORD your God." (Leviticus 18:3-4)

"You shall not worship the LORD your God with such things." (**Deuteronomy 12:4**)

Because of their "cultural" background of false religions, Paul wrote by Holy Spirit inspiration, details of how different Christian worship is from their "cultural" practices:

1) Human philosophy -

That your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God (1 Corinthians 2:5);

2) Divisiveness -

For you are still carnal. For where there are envy, strife, and divisions among you, are you not carnal and behaving like mere men? (1 Corinthians 3:3);

- 3) Sexual immorality "Flee sexual immorality." (1 Corinthians 6:18);
- 4) False worship -

You cannot partake of the Lord's table and of the table of demons (1 Corinthians 10:21).

Worldly cultural practices must be left outside the church of Christ.

Peter wrote:

- **5) We can "resist [the Devil]** steadfast in the faith" (**1 Peter 5:8-9**). Is this your religion?

(Daniel 5:1-6) That very night Belshazzar king of the Chaldeans, was slain (Daniel 5:30).
