"But There's Only 1 Verse"

- There's only 1 verse that commands baptism "for the remission of sins"
- 2. There's only 1 verse that teaches a thief on a cross was saved Luke 23:43;
- There's only 1 verse that teaches Christians should give on "the first day of the week" 1 Corinthians 16:2;

But NO preacher needs more than 1 verse to teach #2 & #3!

- 2. Repentance Was Commanded Luke 24:47; Acts 17:30
- 3. Baptism Called Upon His Name Acts 2:21 ("Joel 2:32"); Acts 22:16; 1 Timothy 1:15-16
- 4. Remission of Sins Is The Result Matthew 26:28
- 5. Gift of The Holy Spirit Offered Acts 2:43; Acts 8:12-18



God Has Used Water For Cleansing:

- 1. Noah's Flood New World Genesis 6:1 - 9:19; 1 Peter 3:18 - 21
- The Red Sea New People Exodus 12 15;
 1 Corinthians 10:1 4
- 3. Levitical Priests New Service Exodus 29:4 - 5; Galatians 3:26 - 27



Objections

- 1. "Must Be Baptised Like Jesus"
 - a. Jesus was the exception Matthew 3:5 6, 15
 - b. NO ONE ELSE is sinless before baptism 1 John 1:8, 10
- 2. Cannot "obey God" and NOT know it's "for the remission of sins"
 - a. Noah knew Hebrews 11:7
 - b. Israelites knew Hebrews 11:29
 - c. Priests knew why they washed;
 - d. Jews Acts 2:38 & Gentiles Acts 10:43, 48



Objections (continued)...

- 3. "Baptism Has Nothing Whatever to do with Salvation"
 - a. Then, why did Jesus exempt Himself from its purpose?
 - b. Why did Peter say it did? 1 Peter 3:21
 - c. Why does the Devil attack it so?
