# (#101) The Proverbs of Solomon 15:27- Bribery Will Get You Nowhere—Good!

Since God Created humans, only God can provide specific understanding of human behavior. God gave Solomon Divine Wisdom (1 Kings Chapters 3 and 10) to explain what and why behavior is as it is, and Proverbs 10:1 - 24:34 are randomly written, as if they were Judgments Solomon made about individual cases brought to him for Divine Wisdom (1 Kings Chapters 3 and 10), or simply Godgiven explanations about life. New Testament passages may help see the continuation of Wisdom offered through Jesus Christ.

#### **Proverbs 15:27:**

He who is greedy for gain troubles his own house, but he who hates bribes will live.

Those who are "greedy for gain" will accept "bribes." The size of the bribe determines the "loyalty" of the perverse! The truth in this proverb is amplified in the teaching of the Apostle Paul:

But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and harmful lusts which drown men in destruction and perdition. For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows. But you, O man of God, flee these things and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, gentleness. (1 Timothy 6:9-11)

A "bribe" is something paid behind the back, under the table, or in the open for influence, profits the one receiving the bribe, who then perverts judgment. "Bribes" destroy justice, fairness, honesty, and will overthrow "the land:"

The king establishes the land by justice, but he who receives bribes overthrows it. (Proverbs 29:4)

### A government is overthrown when:

- Back-door deals determine how a politician votes;
- Lobbyists provide greedy politicians selfish gain for their votes;
- "Civil service" no longer is the desire of "civil servants;"
- Lawyers gain more from their cases than their clients;
- Judges rule according to political power and personal advantage than "blind justice."

What used to be called "bribery" in the retail world, is now "kickbacks," "sweeteners," "carrots." The practice of bribing officials that used to imprison mobsters for "corruption," now is called "investments," "campaign funds," "foundations," "lobbying," "inducements."

- **Jay Leno** once quipped: "Earlier this week the Senate voted 97-to-0 for tougher regulations. For example, when corporations buy a senator, they must now get a receipt."
- **Denis Kearney** has summed up government corruption with these words: "They have seized upon the government by bribery and corruption. They have made speculation and public robbery a science. They have loaded the nation, the state, the county, and the city with debt."
- American Founder **George Washington** said: "Few men have virtue to withstand the highest bidder."
- **Solomon** said: A wicked man accepts a bribe behind the back to pervert the ways of justice. (Proverbs 17:23)
- **God** banned bribes in Moses' Law: And you shall take no bribe, for a bribe blinds the discerning and perverts the words of the righteous. (Exodus 23:8)

God knows human nature better than humans do, and that even "the righteous" can be changed from what's right by bribery. Church leaders like preachers, priests, bishops, and elders further their perversion of truth because of bribes.

A gift in secret pacifies anger, and a bribe behind the back, strong wrath. (Proverbs 21:14)

Bribery is but for a fleeting moment of relief from an immediate situation, but whoever takes the bribe has shown a conscience that has a price. Someone else's "price" will also be accepted!

Surely oppression destroys a wise man's reason, and a bribe debases the heart. (Ecclesiastes 7:7)

Because only corruption and compromised principles of righteousness are associated with "bribery," God cannot be bribed!

For the LORD your God is God of gods and Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome, who shows no partiality nor takes a bribe. (Deuteronomy 10:17)

But he who does wrong will be repaid for what he has done, and there is no partiality. (Colossians 3:25)

Bribery will get you nowhere with God, and nowhere for good!
