

B. Because of what sinners know

1. v.19-20: "What may be known

of God"

2. v.21:"They knew God;"

3. v.23-25:They exchanged "the truth of God" for "the lie;"

4. v.28: They "did not like to retain God in their knowledge"

5. v.30: They know to be "haters of God"



6. v.32: They know the "righteous judgment of God"

How Do We "Approve" Of Sin?

- >Protecting their "things" Acts 8:1
- Keeping children involved in worldly activities above seeking the kingdom first Matthew 6:33
- ➤ Insisting on schools where God is removed and animalism (Evolution) is elevated Romans 1:22-25
- ➤ Attending social functions emphasizing hormones, not holiness 1
 Thessalonians 4:3-5
