- 1. Paul thanked God for their faith and love 1:15-16
- 2. Paul desired their greater understanding of:
  - a) "the knowledge of Him" 1:17
  - b) "the hope of His calling" 1:18
  - c) "the exceeding greatness of His power" toward believers 1:19
  - d) the exaltation of Christ forever 1:20-21

#### III.Christ's Completed Work 1:22 - 6:20

### A. The Church as Christ's Completed Body 1:22-23

- 1. separated from "trespasses and sins" 2:1-3
- saved by grace "with Christ" 2:4-10
  - a) God "made us alive together with Christ" 2:4-5Cf Romans 6:1-11
  - b) Christians "sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus"2:6-7 Cf Colossians 1:13-14; Revelation 1:5-6
  - c) Saved NOT by *deserving* works, but *discerning* works that obey
    God **2:8-10**

#### B. The Church as Christ's Completed Building 2:11 - 3:21

- 1. Gentiles now included
  - a) Fleshly circumcision no distinction now 2:11-13
  - b) Abolition of enmity between Jew and Gentile 2:14-18
  - c) "Holy temple in the Lord" 2:19-22
- 2. Gentiles now receive:
  - a) "dispensation of the grace of God" 3:1-2
  - b) divinely inspired revelation 3:3-5

- c) deliberate inclusion "in Christ" 3:6-7
- 3. Gentiles now are:
  - a) receivers of "the unsearchable riches of Christ" 3:8
  - b) in "the fellowship of the mystery" 3:9
  - c) in the church God eternally planned 3:10-13
  - d) in the church that glorifies God 3:14-21

- 2. With clear "eyes" of proposition 5:8-21
- 3. With bodies for powerful purpose **5:22-6:9** 
  - a) Husbands originate good for their wives **5:22-33**
  - b) Fathers originate good for their children 6:1-4
  - c) Workers and employers originate good for each other 6:5-9

# **Ephesian Epitaphs:**

#### 1. The church:

- began there with Apollo's' incomplete doctrinal preaching (Acts 18:24-19:7);
- continued with Paul's 2-year "and a time" extension (Acts 19:10, 22);
- 3. was strengthened by Paul's exhortation to the Ephesian elders (Acts 20:16-21:1);
- 4. received the book of **Ephesians**;
- commended by Jesus as testing false apostles and outlasting difficulties, but condemned by Jesus as leaving their "first love" (Revelation 2:1-7). No church was given more doctrinal purity than Ephesus and went so far away internally.
- Corinthians represented Achaia of Paul's 2nd journey, Galatians probably went to the churches of Paul's 1st journey, Ephesians may have been intended for circulation among the Asian churches (Revelation 1:11). It is possible, than, that this may have been "the epistle from Laodicea" mentioned in Colossians 4:16.
- 3. The books of **Ephesians** and **Colossians** are strikingly similar, and probably written at the same time.
