2-15-2016 The Youth Vote

When Solomon died, the nation of Israel divided into Northern Israel and Southern Judah, separate Kingdoms.

Rehoboam consulted the elders who stood before his father Solomon while he still lived (1 Kings 12:6)

They advised him to serve the people.

But he rejected the advice which the elders had given him, and consulted the young men who had grown up with him, who stood before him (1 Kings 12:8).

Rehoboam rejected the advice of the older men, listened to "the young men" and promised greater government oppression:

My father chastised you with whips, but I will chastise you with scourges (1 Kings 12:11).

There were good reasons why older men knew more about the future than younger men. Younger men held sway over such a decision, and Southern Judah drifted into ungodly oblivion.

A woman caught in adultery, in the very act [was brought to Jesus, who lived under Moses' Law]. The scribes and Pharisees [forced the issue:] "Now Moses, in the law, commanded us that such should be stoned. But what do You say?" (John 8:4, 5).

Jesus knew Moses had commanded:

The adulterer and the adulteress, shall surely be put to death (Leviticus 20:10).

They had violated Moses' Law by not bringing the man to also be stoned, as she had violated that Law against the act of adultery! Jesus said:

"He who is without sin among you, let him throw a stone at her first" (John 8:7).

[Guilty consciences sent the people away], beginning with the oldest even to the last (John 8:9).

Older people should have well-developed consciences and know when they have sinned.
