After leading Jesus' enemies to Him, he confessed

"I have sinned by betraying innocent blood" (Matthew 27:4).

"Betrayal" consisted of leading enemies to Jesus for personal gain, not truth and right. Whether he paid from his pocket or some "foundation," good works could not cancel the need for repentance!

The Son of Man indeed goes just as it is written of Him, but woe to that man by whom the Son of Man is betrayed! It would have been good for that man if he had not been born (Matthew 26:24).
