God delivered the Israelites from Egyptian slavery, leading them through Moses.

By faith they passed through the Red Sea as by dry land (Hebrews 11:29).

But they refused to enter the Promised Land, and rebelled against God. Concerning those "twenty years old and above" (Numbers 14:29), God swore that

They would not enter His rest... who did not obey... So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief" (**Hebrews 3:18-19**).

- (1) No one was saved without being baptized;
- (2) Baptized believers could become unbelievers;
- (3)"Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience" (**Hebrews 4:11**).

And these stones shall be for a memorial to the children of Israel forever (Joshua 4:5-7).
