### 1-24-2022 Cruelty with Words

King Saul's army faced the Philistines,

And a champion went out from the camp of the Philistines, named Goliath, from Gath, whose height was six cubits and a span. (1 Samuel 17:4)

Goliath's height was 9 1/2 feet, and his armor weighed over 125 pounds! For over a month, he said,

"I defy the armies of Israel this day; give me a man, that we may fight together." (1 Samuel 17:10)

David's faith was bigger than his body, so:

[Goliath] disdained him; for he was only a youth, ruddy and good looking. So the Philistine said to David, 'Am I a dog, that you come to me with sticks?' And the Philistine cursed David by his gods.

(1 Samuel 17:42-43)

Words that either boast of one's own self, or belittle someone else, are cruel. Like David, our faith can defeat any cruel Goliath, even on-line!

### 1-25-2022 Bullies at the Cross

And those who passed by blasphemed Him, wagging their heads and saying, 'Aha! You who destroy the temple and build it in three days, save Yourself, and come down from the cross!' Likewise the chief priests also, mocking among themselves with the scribes, said, 'He saved others; Himself He cannot save.' (Mark 15:29-31)

The blasphemers hurled "fake news" at Him, for Jesus never said He would tear down and rebuild the Temple in Jerusalem in 3 days. The "chief priests" "mocking among themselves," or boldly misrepresenting His doctrine of salvation in their

"private group!" They had to admit Jesus "saved others," but ignored why He could not save Himself. Someone had to die to give bullies like them a chance to do better!

[Christ has] loved us and given Himself for us. (Ephesians 5:1)
